



Materials: Of Patons Beehive Fingering 3-ply, Patonised, 4 (4) ozs. Light Navy 2015 and 1 (1) oz. each Lipstick Red 104 and White. A pair each No. 10 and No. 11 "Beehive" needles, the 11's to be double-pointed and 14 ins. long. Eight large pearl buttons. Bias binding.

Measurements: To fit 34-35 (36-37) inch bust; length from top of shoulders, 20½ (20½) ins.

Tension: 8 sts. and 10 rows to an inch over stocking-stitch on No. 11 needles.

N.B.—Instructions for large size given in brackets thus (). Where one set of figures is given, this applies to both sizes. N.=Navy. R.=Red. W.=White.

BACK

With No. 11 needles and N. wool, cast on 112 (120) sts. and work 2 ins. k. 1, p. 1 rib.

** Change to stocking-stitch, starting with a knit row and work straight until back measures 5 (5) ins. from start, ending with a purl row.

In holiday

Join in W. and continue in stocking-stitch in stripes as follows:—1ST row: right side facing, knit in W. Do not turn work—just slip stitches back to other end of needle. 2ND row: Knit in N. 3RD row: Purl in N. Do not turn work—slip stitches back to other end of needle. 4TH row: Purl in W.

5TH row: Knit in N. 6TH row: Purl in N. These 6 rows form the striped pattern.

Continue in striped pattern and shape sides by increasing 1 stitch at each end of next and every following 6th row until there are 134 (142) sts. *Meanwhile*, when 17 N. stripes are done, continue in the striped pattern but use R. instead of N. When the side increasings are

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done, work straight in stripes of R. and W. until back measures 13 (13) ins. down centre from start.

With right side facing, continue in striped pattern in R. and W. and shape armholes by casting off 3 (4) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of next and every following alternate row until 122 (128) sts. remain. Work straight in striped pattern until 18 R. stripes have been done in all and ending with a W. stripe.

Change to stocking-stitch in N. and work straight for 16 rows. With right side facing, shape armholes outwards as follows:—Increase 1 stitch at each end of next and every following 6th row until there are 132 (138) sts. Change to No. 10 needles and work 5 rows k. 1, p. 1 rib.

With right side facing, shape shoulders as follows:—NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 4 sts., turn; rib to last 4 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 8 sts., turn; rib to last 8 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 12 sts., turn; rib to last 12 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 16 sts., turn; rib to last 16 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 20 sts., turn; rib to last 20 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 24 sts., turn; rib to last 24 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 28 sts., turn; rib to last 28 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 32 sts., turn; rib to last 32 sts., turn. NEXT 2 rows: Rib to last 36 sts., turn; rib to last 36 sts., turn. Rib to end, picking up loop where work was turned each time and knitting it together with next stitch to avoid a hole. Rib back across all stitches, picking up loop and knitting it together with next stitch as before. Cast off right across very loosely in rib. **

FRONT

With No. 11 needles and N. wool, cast on 140 (148) sts. and work 2 ins. k. 1, p. 1 rib. NEXT row: Rib first 14 (14) sts. and slip on a safety-pin, rib to last 14 (14) sts., slip last 14 (14) sts. on a second safety-pin.

Now work as for back from ** to **.

TO MAKE UP

Press parts carefully on wrong side under a damp cloth. With N. wool and No. 11 needles, continue in rib on each of the 14 sts. on safety-pins until piece measures 5 (5) ins. from start. Cast off in rib. Join these ribbed pieces to sides of front. Now join sides of main work, leaving ribbed pieces free to fold over to back then sew in position with two large pearl buttons as shown in photograph. Catch down overlaps to main work along lower edge. Face armholes on wrong side with bias binding.

Now fold neck edge of front over to back along shoulder edges by ½ inch. Sew two buttons on each shoulder through double thickness to secure shoulders. Press seams.

DOUBLE QUICK CABLE CARDIGAN

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SLEEVES

With No. 10 needles, cast on 46 (46) sts. and work 3 ins. k. 2, p. 2 rib. Change to No. 8 needles and stocking-stitch, shaping sides by increasing 1 stitch at each end of 13th and every following 6th row until there are 72 (72) sts. Work straight until sleeve seam measures 17½ (17½) ins.

With right side facing, shape top by casting off 3 (3) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of every knit row until 40 (40) sts. remain, then at each end of every row until 16 (16) sts. remain. Cast off.

NECKBAND AND FRONT BORDERS

Join shoulder seams. *Borders:* With No. 10 needles, cast on 7 sts. and work a strip in garter-stitch, i.e., every row knit, to go up left front when slightly stretched; leave stitches on a safety-pin. Sew neatly in position. Work a similar piece for right front with the addition of 8 buttonholes—first to come ½ inch from lower edge, 8th about ¼ inch from top and remainder evenly spaced between. First mark position of buttons on left front with pins to ensure even spacing, then make holes to correspond. To make a buttonhole:—K. 3, wool forward, k. 2 tog., k. 2. When border is done, sew in position and leave stitches on safety-pin as before.

Neckband: With right side facing and No. 10 needles, k. 7 sts. from safety-pin on right front, pick up and k. 20 (20) sts. up right side of neck, k. 32 (33) sts. from spare needle at back, pick up and k. 20 (21) sts. down left side of neck, k. 7 sts. from safety-pin: 86 (88) sts.
NEXT row: Knit. NEXT row: k. 14 (15), * k. 2 tog., k. 12 (12); repeat from * to last 2 (3) sts., k. 2 (3). Knit 6 rows. Cast off with wrong side facing.

TO MAKE UP

Press parts carefully on wrong side under a damp cloth, taking care not to flatten the cables or ribbing. Join side and sleeve seams; insert sleeves. Sew on buttons. Press all seams.

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
