

# FORECAST FOR THE SE

## TWO-COLOUR CARDIGAN

**Materials:** 14 ozs. Light Turquoise 1952 and 2 ozs. Gold 2245 of Patons Moorland Double Knitting. A pair each No. 9 and No. 8 "Beehive" needles. Five buttons.

**Measurements:** To fit 34-35-inch bust; length from top of shoulders, 20½ inches; sleeve seam, 17½ inches.

**Tension:** 5 sts. to an inch over stocking-stitch.  
N.B.—B.=Light Turquoise; G.=gold.

## BACK

With No. 9 needles and B. wool, cast on 92 sts. and work 6 inches, k. 1, p. 1 rib. Change to No. 8 needles and pattern. 1st row: right side facing, with B. k. 5, \* slip 2 purlways, k. 6; repeat from \* to last 7 sts., sl. 2 purlways, k. 5. 2nd row: purl in B. Repeat these 2 rows 3 times more. Break B. wool.

9th row: Join in G. as 1st row. Break G. Rejoin B. 10th row: purl in B. These 10 rows form pattern.

Continue in pattern, shaping sides by increasing

*thick wool casual cardigan with a good neckline*



1 stitch at each end of next and every following 8th row until there are 102 sts.

Work straight to end of 6th pattern. With right side facing, shape armholes by casting off 5 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog.

*plus an*

at each end of next and every alternate row until 82 sts. remain.

Continue straight to end of 13th pattern, then with right side facing, shape shoulders by casting off 9 sts. at beginning of next 6 rows. Cast off.

### FRONTS

*Left:* With No. 9 needles and B. wool, cast on 52 sts. and work 6 inches k. 1, p. 1 rib.

Change to No. 8 needles and work in pattern as for back, sloping front edge by decreasing 1 stitch at end of 3rd and at this edge on every following 5th row. *At the same time*, shape side edge by increasing 1 stitch at beginning of 11th and every following 8th row, 5 times in all.

When side increasings are done, keep this edge straight and continue to slope front edge by decreasing on every 5th row as before. When side edge matches back, with right side facing, shape armhole by casting off 5 sts. at beginning of next row, then k. 2 tog. at this edge on every alternate row, 5 times, then keep this edge straight, but continue sloping front edge as before until 27 sts. remain.

Work straight until front matches back, then with right side facing, shape shoulder by casting off 9 sts. at beginning of next and following 2 alternate rows, armhole edge.

*Right:* Work to correspond with left front, reversing shapings, and with the addition of 5 buttonholes in welt ribbing. First to come  $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch from lower edge and remaining 4 at  $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch intervals. To ensure even spacing, first mark position of buttons on left front with pins, then work holes to correspond. To make a buttonhole:—with right side facing, rib 3, cast off 4, rib to end and back, casting on 4 over those cast off.

### SLEEVES

With No. 9 needles and B. wool, cast on 40 sts. and work 3 inches k. 1, p. 1 rib, increasing 4 sts. evenly across on last row.

Change to No. 8 needles and pattern as for back, increasing 1 stitch at each end of 7th and every following 6th row until there are 76 sts. Work straight to end of 14th pattern.

With right side facing, shape top by casting off 5 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at beginning of every row until 20 sts. remain. Cast off.

### COLLAR

Join shoulder seams. With No. 9 needles, B. wool and right side facing, pick up and k. 105 sts. up right front, starting at top of welt and ending at centre back of neck. Work 1 inch in k. 1, p. 1 rib on these stitches ending at centre back of neck. Shape collar as follows:—rib 7, turn and rib back; rib 14, turn and rib back; rib 21, turn and rib back. Continue thus until there are 7 sts. unworked at end of needle. Cast off right across. Work other half of collar to correspond. Turn back lower edges of collar and catch down at top of welt.

### TO MAKE UP

Press parts on wrong side under a damp cloth, avoiding ribbing. Join side and sleeve seams, insert sleeves. Sew on buttons. Press seams.
