



TEEN-AGE JUMPER

MATERIALS—W.G. Braeburn Real Shetland, 6 ozs. natural, and 3 ozs. royal blue; knitting needles, two No. 10 and two No. 12; medium steel crochet hook; 3 buttons.

TENSION—About 15 sts. to 2 inches in width and 10 rows to 1 inch in depth, over Fair Isle pattern.

MEASUREMENTS—To fit a 33 to 35-inch bust; length from shoulder to lower edge, 20 inches; sleeve seam, 18 inches.

ABBREVIATIONS FOR COLOURS—N., natural; r., royal blue.

Back—With n., and No. 12 needles, begin at lower edge, casting on 116 sts.

1st row—P. 1, (k. 2, p. 2) till 3 rem., k. 2, p. 1. **2nd row**—K. 1, (p. 2, k. 2) till 3 rem., p. 2, k. 1. Rep. these 2 rows for 3 inches, ending with 2nd row. Change to No. 10 needles. **Next row**—Inc., (k. 6, inc.) till 3 rem., k. 3. **Next row**—P. [133 sts.]. Join on r. Work as Chart A from 1st to 14th row, then from 13th back to 1st row. * Break off n. **28th row**—P.

Next 13 rows—K. **42nd row**—P. Join on n. * Work as Chart B on page 27 from 43rd to 56th row, then from 55th back to 43rd row. Rep. from * to *. Work as Chart A from 1st to 12th row. Now shape armholes. Continue in patt., casting off 6 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows, then dec. one st. at beg. and end of the next 8 rows. Work 5 rows in patt. Rep. from * to *. **127th row**—Work 53 in patt., slip these sts. on to st.-holder, inc. r., work in patt. to end. Work 26 rows in patt. Break off n. **154th row**—P.

Next 2 rows—K. **157th row**—K. 17, slip these sts. on to a piece of wool, k. to end. Shape shoulder. **158th row**—Cast off 8, k. till 2 rem., dec. **159th row**—Dec., k. to end. Rep. last 2 rows once, then rep. 158th row. Cast off. Slip sts. from st.-holder to needle, point towards centre. Work 26 rows in patt. Break off n.

154th row—P. **155th row**—K. Rep. 157th

row, then shape shoulder, rep. 158th and 159th rows 3 times. Cast off.

Front—Work as back until 127th row is reached, then work 27 rows in patt. Break off n. **154th row**—P. 43, slip next 19 sts. on to a piece of wool, then slip the rem. 43 sts. on to st.-holder. **Work in garter-st., dec. one st. at neck edge in every row until 31 sts. rem. **Next 2 rows**—K. Shape shoulder. Cast off 8 sts. at beg. of next 3 rows, starting from armhole edge. Cast off **. Slip sts. from st.-holder to needle, point towards neck, join on r. **154th row**—P. Rep. from ** to **.

Sleeves [both alike].—Begin at lower edge, using n. wool and No. 12 needles, cast on 64 sts. Work in rib as for back, inc. one st. at beg. and end of 7th row, and every 6th row following until there are 90 sts. on needle, then inc. one st. at beg. and end of every 8th row until there are 102 sts. Cont. on 102 sts. until sleeve measures 18 inches, or length required. Shape top. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows, then dec. one st. at beg. of every row until 68 sts. rem., then dec. one st. at beg. and end of every row until 26 sts. rem. Cast off.

Neck ribbing—Join shoulder seams. With n. wool and No. 12 needles, and with right side facing, k. 17 sts. from wool; pick up and k. 26 sts. across shoulder to front; k. 19 from wool; pick up and k. 25 sts. across shoulder to back; k. 17 from wool [104 sts.]. Work in rib of k. 2, p. 2 for 11 rows. Cast off loosely in rib. Work 4 rows d.c. along left side of back opening, and 1 row along right side, making three 5-ch. loops at equal distances apart for buttonholes.

To Make Up—Press Fair Isle part on wrong side, using a hot iron over a damp cloth, do not press ribbing. Sew up side and sleeve seams and sew in sleeves. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.
