Materials: 8 [8] ozs. Patons Beehive Fingering 3-ply, Patonised, in Duck Egg 177. A pair No. 11 "Beehive" needles. A 4-inch lightweight matching zip-fastener.

Measurements: To fit 34-35 [36-37] inch bust; length from top of shoulders, 21 [21] inches; sleeve seam, 12 [12] inches.

Tension: 8 sts. and 10 rows to an inch over stocking-stitch.

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LACE PANEL JUMPER

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N.B.—Instructions for large size given in brackets thus []. Where one set of figures is given, this applies to both sizes.

LACE PATTERN PANEL

1ST ROW: right side facing, p. 2, k. 2, wool forward, k. 2 tog. through back of loops, p. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 2, wool forward, k. 1, wool forward, k. 5, slip 1, k. 1, pass slipped stitch over, p. 2, k. 2, wool forward, k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2.

2ND ROW: k. 2, p. 2, wool round needle, p. 2 tog., k. 2, p. 12, k. 2, p. 2, w.r.n., p. 2 tog., k. 2.

3RD ROW: p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 1, wl. fwd., k. 3, wl. fwd., k. 4, sl. 1, k. 1, p.s.s.o., p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2. 4TH ROW: As 2nd.

5TH ROW: p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2, k. 2 tog., wl. fwd., k. 5, wl. fwd., k. 3, sl. 1, k. 1, p.s.s.o., p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2. 6TH ROW: As 2nd.

7TH ROW: p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 5, wl. fwd., k. 1, wl. fwd., k. 2, sl. 1, k. 1, p.s.s.o., p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2. 8TH ROW: As 2nd.

9TH ROW: p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 4, wl. fwd., k. 3, wl. fwd., k. 1, sl. 1, k. 1, p.s.s.o., p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2. 10TH ROW: As 2nd.

11TH ROW: p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 3, wl. fwd., k. 5, wl. fwd., sl. 1, k. 1, p.s.s.o., p. 2, k. 2, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.t.b.l., p. 2. 12TH ROW: As 2nd. These 12 rows form pattern and are repeated throughout.

FRONT

Cast on 122 [130] sts. loosely and work 16 [16] rows stocking-stitch, starting with a knit row. Make a hem on next row by knitting 1 stitch from needle together with 1 from cast-on edge. Purl back.

Continue in stocking-stitch with centre 28 [28] sts. in lace pattern thus:—1ST ROW: right side facing, k. 47 [51], pattern across next 28 [28] sts. as given on 1st pattern row, k. 47 [51].

2ND ROW: p. 47 [51], pattern 28 [28] as given on 2nd pattern row, p. 47 [51]. 3RD ROW: k. 47 [51], pattern 28 [28] as on 3rd pattern row, k. 47 [51]. 4TH ROW: p. 47 [51], pattern 28 [28] as on 4th pattern row, p. 47 [51].

Continue thus in stocking-stitch and lace pattern and at the same time decrease in stocking-stitch parts for waist thus:—

NEXT ROW: k. 2 tog., k. 26 [28], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 14 [16], pattern 28 [28], k. 14 [16], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 26 [28], k. 2 tog. (116 [124] sts.). Work 7 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: k. 2 tog., k. 24 [26], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 13 [15], pattern 28 [28], k. 13 [15], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 24 [26], k. 2 tog. (110 [118] sts.). Work 7 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: k. 2 tog., k. 22 [24], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 12 [14], pattern 28 [28], k. 12 [14], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 22 [24], k. 2 tog. (104 [112] sts.). Work 7 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: k. 2 tog., k. 20 [22], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 11 [13], pattern 28 [28], k. 11 [13], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 20 [22], k. 2 tog. (98 [106] sts.). Work 7 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: k. 2 tog., k. 18 [20], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 10 [12], pattern 28 [28], k. 10 [12], k. 2 tog.t.b.l., k. 1, k. 2 tog., k. 18 [20], k. 2 tog. (92 [100] sts.). Work 27 rows straight in pattern. This completes waist shaping.

Continue in pattern, increasing as follows:—NEXT ROW: right side facing, knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 19 [21], pick up and knit into back of horizontal thread before next stitch, this will be called "increase 1" k. 1, increase 1, k. 11 [13], pattern 28 [28], k. 11 [13], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 19 [21], knit twice in last stitch (98 [106] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 21 [23], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 12 [14], pattern 28 [28], k. 12 [14], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 21 [23], knit twice in last stitch (104 [112] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 23 [25], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 13 [15], pattern 28 [28], k. 13 [15], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 23 [25], knit twice in last stitch (110 [118] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 25 [27], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 14 [16], pattern 28 [28], k. 14 [16], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 25 [27], knit twice in last stitch (116 [124] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 27 [29], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 15 [17], pattern 28 [28], k. 15 [17], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 27 [29], knit twice in last stitch (122 [130] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 29 [31], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 16 [18], pattern 28 [28], k. 16 [18], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 29 [31], knit twice in last stitch (128 [136] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 31 [33], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 17 [19], pattern 28 [28], k. 17 [19], increase 1, k. 1, increase 1, k. 31 [33], knit twice in last stitch (134 [142] sts.). Work 5 rows straight in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Knit twice in 1st stitch, k. 52 [56], pattern 28 [28], k. 52 [56], knit twice in last stitch (136 [144] sts.). Work straight until front measures 13½ [13½] inches at centre.

With right side facing, continue in pattern and shape armholes by casting off 8 [8] sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of every knit row until 108 [114] sts. remain. Work straight in pattern until front measures 21 [21] inches at centre.

With right side facing, shape shoulders by casting off 11 [11] sts. at beginning of next 6 rows. Change to stocking-stitch and work 12 [12] rows straight in stocking-stitch on remaining 42 [48] sts. Cast off loosely.

BACK

Work hem exactly as given for front. NEXT ROW: Purl. Continue in stocking-stitch over all sts. for a further 4 rows.

With right side facing, continue in stocking-stitch over all sts., decreasing for waist exactly as given for front: 92 [100] sts. remain. Work 27 rows straight in stocking-stitch. Now with right side facing, continue in stocking-stitch and work increasings exactly as given for front on next and every following 6th row until there are 136 [144] sts. Work straight until back matches front.

With right side facing, shape armholes by casting off 8 [8] sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of every knit row until 108 [114] sts. remain. Work straight until back measures 18 [18] inches at centre. Here divide for back opening.

NEXT ROW: right side facing, k. 53 [56], turn and leave remaining sts. on a spare needle. Continue straight in stocking-stitch on first half of work until back matches front.

With right side facing, shape shoulder by casting off 11 [11] sts. at beginning of next and following 2 alternate rows, armhole edge. Work 12 rows stocking-stitch on remaining sts.; cast off loosely.

With right side facing, rejoin wool to remaining 55 [58] sts., cast off centre 2, then work last 53 [56] sts. to correspond with first shoulder.

SLEEVES

Cast on 74 [74] sts. and work hem exactly as given for front. Purl back.

Continue in stocking-stitch, shaping sides by increasing 1 stitch at each end of 7th and every following 8th row until there are 96 [96] sts. Work straight until sleeve seam measures 12 [12] inches.

With right side facing, shape top by casting off 3 [3] sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at beginning of every row until 52 [52] sts. remain, then at each end of every row until 24 [24] sts. remain. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Press parts very carefully on wrong side under a damp cloth. Join side, shoulder and sleeve seams; insert sleeves. Fold under 6 rows of stocking-stitch round neck and slip hem very loosely to wrong side. Insert zip up back opening. Press seams.

JACOBAN SQUARE

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threads tied at intersections with brown crosses; stars, light rust straight stitches (diagram 3); outline, brown and tan stem-stitch. Left half: light rust long-and-short slanting buttonhole, outlined peach stem-stitch; veins, brown Roumanian stitch; centre vein, continuation of main stem as single line of brown stem-stitch. Tendril: dark blue coral stitch.

Press finished embroidery carefully on wrong side under a damp cloth and make up into a 17-inch square cushion with the contrasting back.
