



stocking-stitch, then continue in moss-stitch (*i.e.*, k. 1, p. 1 every row) until back measures $19\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Shape shoulders by casting off 9 sts. at beginning of next 6 rows. Cast off.

FRONTS

Left: Make pocket lining. With No. 10 needles and main shade, cast on 26 sts. and work 22 rows stocking-stitch, ending with a purl row, leave on spare needle.

With No. 10 needles and main shade, cast on 30 sts. and work in stocking-stitch, keeping side edge straight and increasing at front on every row until there are 47 sts. Now continue to increase at front edge, but decrease also at side edge on next and every following 4th row four times (56 sts.). Keep front edge straight and decrease twice more at side edge as before. NEXT ROW: p. 54.

NEXT ROW: Work in pocket:—k. 14, cast off 26, k. 14. Purl back, working in 26 sts. for pocket in place of those cast off. Work straight for 10 more rows, then increase at side edge on next and every following 4th row until there are 65 sts. Work straight until side edge measures $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

MATERIALS: 8 ozs. Patons Beehive Fingering, 3-ply, in main shade, and 2 ozs. light contrast. A pair each No. 10 and No. 12 "Beehive" needles. Five buttons. You will have a fairly big ball of each shade left over.

MEASUREMENTS: To fit 34–36-inch bust; length from top of shoulders, 21 inches; sleeve seam, $18\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

TENSION: $7\frac{1}{2}$ stitches to an inch.

BACK

With No. 10 needles and main shade, cast on 104 sts. and work in stocking-stitch for 18 rows. In next and every following 4th row decrease at each end of every row until 92 remain, then work 12 rows straight.

Now increase at each end of next and every following 4th row until there are 118 sts. Work straight until side edge measures $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches, then shape armholes by casting off 6 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. K. 2 tog. at each end of every row until 90 sts. remain, then decrease at beginning of next row to get an odd number of sts.

Change to contrasting wool, work 1 row

PLAIN and PRACTICAL *Moss and Stocking Stitch*

Cast off 6 sts. at beginning of next row, side edge, then k. 2 tog. on every row this side until 51 remain. With front of work facing, change to contrast wool and work 1 row stocking-stitch and 5 rows moss. Increase on next row thus:—Moss 24, (k. 1, p. 1, k. 1 all into next st., moss 5) 4 times, moss 3. NEXT ROW: Moss. NEXT ROW: Moss 28, (k. 1, p. 1, k. 1 all into next st., moss 5) 5 times, moss 1 (69 sts.).

Continue in moss-stitch, decreasing at front edge on next and every following 4th row, 4 times. NEXT ROW: Moss 27, p. 3 tog., (moss 5, p. 3 tog.) 4 times, moss 3. NEXT ROW: Moss. NEXT ROW: Moss 23, (p. 3 tog., moss 5) 4 times. NEXT ROW: Moss.

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Right: Work to correspond with left front, with shapings at opposite ends of needle.

Ribbing: With No. 11 needles, cast on 12 sts. and work a length of k. 1, p. 1 rib, long enough to go round both fronts and back of neck. Make 4 buttonholes up front edge, the first $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from bottom, and remaining 3 at intervals of $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. To make a buttonhole:—Rib 4, cast off 4, rib 4. Cast on 4 sts. over those cast off in next row.

SLEEVES

With No. 11 needles, cast on 38 sts. and work 2 inches k. 2, p. 2 rib. Change to No. 10 needles and pattern, increasing at each end of every 6th row until there are 58 sts. on needle. Work straight until side edge measures 14 inches or required length.

Shape top by casting off 3 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of every 3rd row until 24 remain. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Pin cut pieces to measurements, and press carefully on wrong side, avoiding ribbing. Sew together side, shoulder and sleeve seams of cardigan; insert sleeves. Sew ribbing round neck and sew on buttons. For jumper join seams as for cardigan, except for shoulders, which are left open for 2 inches each side of neck. Work round openings in double crochet, making loops for 3 buttons, each side; sew on buttons.

PLAIN AND PRACTICAL

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Continue in moss, decreasing at neck edge on next and following 4th rows three times in all. **NEXT ROW:** * Moss 7, p. 3 tog.; repeat from * to last 4 sts., moss 4. **NEXT 3 ROWS:** Moss.

NEXT ROW: * Moss 7, p. 3 tog.; repeat from * to last 6 sts., moss 6. Continue in moss-stitch, decreasing at neck edge on every 4th row until 27 sts. remain. Work straight until front is same length as back, then shape shoulder by casting off 9 sts. at beginning of next 3 alternate rows, armhole edge.

Right: Work to correspond with left, with shapings at opposite ends of needles.

Ribbing: With No. 12 needles and main shade, cast on 68 sts. and work 10 rows k. 1, p. 1 rib. Cast off fairly loosely. Make another piece the same. These are for bottom of contrasting yokes at front. Stitch to yoke as in photograph, with cast-on edge at bottom and ribbing lying flat on yoke, leaving about 1 inch protruding at front edge.

Make similar strips for bottom of back yoke, casting on 120 sts.; for lower edge of

back, 132 sts.; 2 strips for bottom of sleeves, 72 sts.; 2 strips for pocket tops, 32 sts.

Make two strips for the two fronts, casting on 200 sts., and in second piece make buttonholes in 5th and 6th rows:—Rib 3, (cast off 7, rib 16) four times, cast off 7, rib to end and back, casting on 7 over those cast off.

SLEEVES

With No. 10 needles and main shade, cast on 56 sts. and work $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches stocking-stitch. Now increase at each end of next and every following 6th row until there are 92 sts. on needle. Work straight until side edge measures $17\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Shape top by casting off 2 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. each end of every 3rd row until 78 remain, then at each end of every alternate row until 60 remain, finally each end every 4th row until 54 remain.

Cast off 14 at beginning of next 2 rows; work 20 rows on remaining sts.; cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Press all pieces, except ribbing, on wrong side under a damp cloth. Sew together side, shoulder and sleeve seams; insert sleeves, after stitching sides of the long top piece to cast-off sts. at sides. Sew on ribbing, first tacking carefully in position. Sew on buttons to match buttonholes. Stitch down pockets neatly at back. With contrasting wool work 2 rows d.c. round neck and down front openings in yoke.

RIBBED JUMPER

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continue in rib, increasing at each end of every 6th row until there are 98 sts.

Work straight until side edge measures $18\frac{1}{2}$ inches, then shape top by casting off 5 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of every alternate row until 38 sts. remain. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Do not press. Sew in front panel and join shoulder seams. Work a row of double crochet down right side of back opening. Now with front of work facing and main shade, pick up and knit 110 sts. evenly round neck, using No. 11 needles. Make a contrasting tuck as before, with 9 rows stocking-st., starting with a purl row. Finish tuck with main wool, casting off on next row.

Join sleeve seams and insert sleeves, gathering fullness to top of shoulder. Work a row of double crochet down left side of back opening, making 2 loops for buttons.
